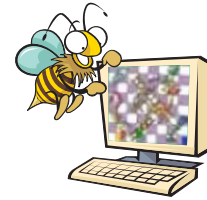

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read this agreement carefully before accessing or using the Activiscope website operated by Learningscope. These Terms and Conditions are designed to ensure that you and your students have a safe and enjoyable experience with Activiscope. The information and services on the Activiscope website are provided by Learningscope subject to your agreement to the Terms and Conditions below.

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

Activiscope is an online service that allows you to create a bank of question and answer lists which you can use in a range of fun interactive activities. In your account you build up a personalised library of activities, which are sorted by topic areas of your choosing. You can also make your lists public so that other users can search for them and use them in their classes. You can choose to use your activities online via the Activiscope.com website, or you can export them as Flash files to use offline, in your own web projects, or as SCORM 2004 resources to distribute through a compatible Virtual Learning Environment (VLE). Exported SCORM resources include automatic marking which sends student performance data to your VLE. Additionally, your students can log on to the Activiscope student portal area where they can work through the activities their teacher(s) have created. Teachers are free to use the activities they have exported without limitations, even after their subscription has expired. For commercial use, a commercial licence will however be necessary.

ACCESS

Subscribing schools purchase a master account (renewable annually) as well as a number of teacher accounts (as needed) for a one-off nominal fee. Each teacher with an account can create activities and publish them on the student portal. Students will gain access to the student portal through a username and password specific to the school. Resources can be accessed from any computer - whether at school or at home.

The registered member for an account is entirely liable for all activities conducted through that account, and is responsible for ensuring that any other person who uses the account is aware of, and complies with, these Terms and Conditions. Each person who uses the account agrees to be bound by these Terms and Conditions, whether or not this person is a member. You will promptly notify us of any known or suspected unauthorised use(s) of your account, or any known or suspected breach of security, including loss, theft, or unauthorised disclosure of your username and password.

SUBSCRIPTION FEE

All subscriptions will be pre-paid annually. Learningscope reserves the right to change the amount of any fees or charges for the Activiscope service, and to institute new fees by posting such changes on the Activiscope website.

To respect your privacy, **Learningscope does not automatically invoice you when your subscription runs out. It is your responsibility to renew your subscription before its expiry date.** You are advised to renew your subscription at least two weeks before your account is due to expire. We will NOT prioritise or fast-track any renewal application as our policy is to process applications on a first-come first-served basis to warrant an equal and fair level of service.

Once you have been invoiced, payment must be received within 30 days. It is your responsibility to forward any invoice to the appropriate person or department for prompt payment. If your account becomes overdue, Learningscope will suspend your access until payment is received. If your account remains overdue, our statutory right to claim interest and compensation for debt recovery costs under the late payment legislation will be exercised.

Please note that we are unable to accept cancellation once your account has been activated. No trial period will be granted as a preview section is freely available.

Your access to the service is by username and password. Each member of staff has their own login details but only one set of username and password per school is issued for access to the student portal. You are free to divulge the student login details to students wholly connected to your institution. However **your login details should not be shared with anyone outside your institution nor should they be displayed publicly (e.g. on a school website or Intranet).** Once your login details are issued it is your responsibility to keep a record of them and their expiry date (reminders will not be sent). You may not select a username that we, in our sole discretion, deem inappropriate, offensive or easy to guess. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your username and password, and you will be responsible for all uses of your username and password, whether or not authorised by you.
